An Act to amend the District Courts Act 1947

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1 Short Title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the District Courts Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the District Courts Act 1947 (“the principal Act”).
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
