The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Frustrated Contracts Amendment Act 2002.
- (2) In this Act, the Frustrated Contracts Act 1944 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 New section 2 substituted

The principal Act is amended by repealing section 2, and substituting the following section:

2 Interpretation

In this Act, **Court** means, in relation to any matter, the court, tribunal, or arbitral tribunal by or before which the matter falls to be determined.
