The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Remuneration Authority Amendment Act 2016.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 March 2017.

3 Principal Act

This Act amends the Remuneration Authority Act 1977 (the **principal Act**).

4 Section 2 amended (Interpretation)

In section 2, replace the definition of **principal allowances** with:

principal allowances—

- (a) means allowances (not being travelling allowances or other incidental or minor allowances); and
- (b) to avoid doubt, in relation to any of the following Judges who does not have his or her primary place of residence in Wellington may, if the Re-

muneration Authority thinks fit, include an amount by way of an allowance for accommodation while that person is in Wellington:

- (i) a Judge of the Supreme Court:
- (ii) a Judge of the Court of Appeal:
- (iii) the Chief High Court Judge
