- 1 Title and commencement**
- (1) This order may be cited as the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments (Commonwealth of Australia) Order 1987.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2 Application to Commonwealth of Australia**
- Part 1 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934 shall extend to the Commonwealth of Australia.
- 3 Superior courts**
- The High Court of Australia and the Federal Court of Australia shall be deemed to be superior courts of the Commonwealth of Australia for the purposes of Part 1 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order enables judgments given in the High Court of Australia and the Federal Court of Australia to be enforced in New Zealand in terms of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934.
