Pursuant to section 64 of the Marriage Act 1955, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## Regulations

### 1 Title and commencement

- (1) These regulations may be cited as the Marriage (Fees) Regulations 1995.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

### 2 Interpretation

In these regulations, **the Act** means the Marriage Act 1955.

### 3 Fees payable to New Zealand representatives

There shall be paid to any New Zealand representative who gives a certificate under section 43 of the Act a fee of \$11 for each such certificate.

### 4 Other fees

There shall be paid to the Registrar-General or, as the case requires, to a registrar, for each of the matters specified in the Schedule, the fee specified for it in the Schedule.

### 5 Goods and services tax included

The fees specified in the Schedule are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

### 6 Revocation

The following regulations are hereby consequentially revoked:
