**Medicines (Approved Laboratories and Analysts in

Pursuant to section 2 of the Medicines Act 1981, the Minister of Health gives the following notice.

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Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Medicines (Approved Laboratories and Analysts in Charge) Notice 2000.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on 20 October 2000.

3 Approved laboratories
