Ship Registration (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2000: revoked, on 1 July 2013, pursuant to regulation 7 of the Ship Registration (Fees) Regulations 2013 (SR 2013/156).

PURSUANT to section 87 of the Ship Registration Act 1992, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Ship Registration (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2000.
- (2) In these regulations, the Ship Registration (Fees) Regulations 1992 (SR 1992/298) are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement
