## **Regulations**

### **1 Title**

These regulations are the Chartered Professional Engineers of New Zealand Levy Regulations 2004.

### **2 Commencement**

These regulations come into force on 16 September 2004.

### **3 Application**

These regulations apply to the financial year ending on 30 June 2005 and subsequent financial years.

### **4 Levy**

The Registration Authority must pay to the Council, in each financial year of the Council, a levy of \$70,000 under section 64 of the Chartered Professional Engineers of New Zealand Act 2002.

### **5 When levy must be paid**

- (1) The Registration Authority must pay that levy on or before 14 July in each year.
- (2) However, the first levy must be paid on or before 30 September 2004.
