Fisheries (Reporting) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2004: revoked, on 1 October 2017, pursuant to regulation 52 of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2017 (LI 2017/154).

Pursuant to section 297(1)(h) of the Fisheries Act 1996, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Part 6A
**Species or classes of fish returned to the sea for which
destination type code M must be used**

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Reporting) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2004.
- (2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 October 2004.

3 Interpretation

Regulation 3(1) of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the definition of **foreign fishing vessel**, the following definition:

green-lipped mussel spat means a shellfish of the species *Perna canaliculus* that is less than 10mm in length.

4 Monthly harvest returns

- (1) Regulation 7(1) of the principal regulations is amended by adding to paragraph (d) the word “; or” and by adding the following paragraph:
 - (e) is an operator who, being a New Zealand national using a New Zealand ship, takes any highly migratory species that is—
 - (i) subject to the quota management system outside New Zealand fisheries waters; and
 - (ii) taken outside New Zealand fisheries waters; and
 - (iii) taken for the purpose of sale
- (2) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after subclause (1), the following subclause:
 - (1A) Regulation 7(1)(e) does not apply, and no monthly harvest return is required, if the operator proves to the satisfaction of the chief executive that—
 - (a) the operator was authorised to take the stock in the national fisheries jurisdiction of another State; and
 - (b) if the other State has a national allocation for the stock taken, the catch was recorded against the other State’s allocation; and

- (c) the other State has agreed to comply with all of the conservation and management measures of the competent regional fisheries management organisation for the relevant species.
- (3) Regulation 7(2)(a) of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from subparagraph (ii) the word “; and”, and substituting the word “; or” and by adding the following subparagraph:
- (iii) in relation to any fish that are—
- (A) taken outside New Zealand fisheries waters; and
- (B) not subject to the quota management system outside New Zealand fisheries waters; and

5 Use of codes for certain entries

Regulation 37(a) of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, after the words “in table 11”, the words “, or, in the case of green-lipped mussel and green-lipped mussel spat, in table 17”.

6 Part 1 of Schedule 3 amended

- (1) Table 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting, from the heading to the third column, the expression “15”, and substituting the expression “18”.
- (2) Table 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the items relating to kahawai and southern bluefin tuna.
- (3) Table 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the following items:

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 2004, amend the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 2001 by—

- inserting a definition for green-lipped mussel spat (regulation 3):
- including, in regulation 7, a requirement for a monthly harvest return to be completed in respect of the taking of highly migratory species, except where certain conditions are satisfied (regulation 4):
- adding, to regulation 37(a), a reference to green-lipped mussel and green-lipped mussel spat (regulation 5):
- inserting, in table 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 3, fishstock codes for species of fish being introduced into the quota management system from 1 October 2004 (regulation 6):
- making consequential amendments to Schedule 3, to take account of the species of fish being introduced into the quota management system (regulations 7 to 9).
