Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Social Security (Childcare Assistance) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2008.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 December 2008.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Social Security (Childcare Assistance) Regulations 2004.

4 Interpretation

- (1) Paragraph (a) of the definition of **approved early-childhood care arranger** in regulation 3(1) is amended by inserting “or a licensed home-based education and care service” after “arranger”.
- (2) Paragraph (a)(i) of the definition of **approved early-childhood education service** in regulation 3(1) is amended by inserting “or an early childhood education and care service licensed under the Education (Early Childhood Services) Regulations 2008” after “Education (Early Childhood Centres) Regulations 1998”.
