Pursuant to sections 20, 21 and 22 of the Real Estate Agents Act 2008, the following notice is given.

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**Notice**

**1 Title and commencement**

- (1) This notice may be cited as the Real Estate Agents Authority (Fees and Levies) Notice 2009.
- (2) This notice comes into force on 17 November 2009 and applies to fees and levies from 17 November 2009.

**2 Fees and levies**

The Real Estate Agents Authority sets the following fees and levies, payable to the Registrar or the Authority, specified in the attached Schedule.

The fees are exclusive of goods and services tax.
