Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Biosecurity (Deer and Other Testing Costs) Amendment Regulations 2013.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 July 2013.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Biosecurity (Deer and Other Testing Costs) Regulations 1998 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 2 amended (Interpretation)

- (1) In regulation 2(1), revoke the definition of **Board**.
- (2) In regulation 2(1), insert in its appropriate alphabetical order: “**TBfree New Zealand** means TBfree New Zealand Limited”.

5 Regulation 3 amended (Matters for which costs are recoverable)

- (1) In regulation 3(1), replace “the Board” with “TBfree New Zealand”.
- (2) In regulation 3(2)(b), replace “the Board” with “TBfree New Zealand (or, if notified before 1 July 2013, by or on behalf of the Animal Health Board (Incorporated))”.

6 Regulation 6 amended (Waiver or refund of costs)

In regulation 6, replace “the Board” with “TBfree New Zealand” in each place.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 2013, amend the Biosecurity (Deer and Other Testing Costs) Regulations 1998. References to the Animal Health Board (Incorporated) are replaced with references to TBfree New Zealand Limited, which is the new management agency for the purposes of the Biosecurity (National Bovine Tuberculosis Pest Management Plan) Order 1998.
