2 Commencement of most remaining provisions of Legislation Act 2012

The following provisions of the Legislation Act 2012 come into force on 5 August 2013:

- (a) Subparts 1 and 2 of Part 2;
- (b) Part 3;
- (c) Section 77(2), (3), (4), (6), and (7);
- (d) the Schedule (except the items relating to the Biosecurity Act 1993).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force on 5 August 2013 most of the balance of the Legislation Act 2012. The provisions brought into force by this order are—

- subpart 1 of Part 2 (publishing legislation);
- subpart 2 of Part 2 (reprints);
- Part 3 (subordinate legislation: disallowable instruments and incorporation of material by reference);
- the remaining provisions of section 77 and most of the Schedule (repeals, consequential amendments, and savings provisions).

The only provisions not brought into force by this order are the items in the Schedule that would consequentially amend the Biosecurity Act 1993. It is intended that those items will be replaced by an amending Act.
