**1 Title**

**2 Commencement**

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Meaning of registers**

In this notice, the **registers** means the Fishing Vessel Register, the Permit Register, and the High Seas Permit Register.

**4 Location of registers**

The registers must be located at the offices of Commercial Fisheries Services Limited at Level 1, 74 Cambridge Terrace, Wellington.

**5 Hours of inspection**

The registers must be open for inspection by the public from 8 am until 5 pm on any day except—

- (a) a Saturday, a Sunday, Waitangi Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, the Sovereign's birthday, and Labour Day; and
- (b) the day observed as anniversary day in Wellington; and
- (c) a day in the period beginning on 25 December in a year and ending on 2 January in the following year; and
- (d) if 1 January falls on a Friday, the following Monday; and
- (e) if 1 January falls on a Saturday or a Sunday, the following Monday and Tuesday.

**6 Revocation**

The Fisheries (Location and Inspection of Registers) Notice 2007 (SR 2007/220) is revoked.

### **Explanatory note**
