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Order

1 Title

This order is the Commerce (Part 4 Regulation—Gas Pipeline Services) Order 2014.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

In the Commerce Act 1986, Schedule 6, after the item relating to Cheal Petroleum Limited, insert:

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, adds the Ahuroa gas storage pipeline to Schedule 6 of the Commerce Act 1986.

The effect of adding this item is to exempt the pipeline from the requirements of information disclosure and price-quality regulation that apply in relation to gas pipeline services under subpart 10 of Part 4 of the Commerce Act 1986.
