Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Amendment Regulations 2014: revoked, on 1 April 2015, by regulation 5 of the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Amendment Regulations 2015 (LI 2015/34).

Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Amendment Regulations 2014.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 April 2014.
- 3 Principal regulations**
These regulations amend the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Regulations 2005 (the **principal regulations**).
- 4 Schedule 2 amended**
In each provision of Schedule 2 of the principal regulations listed in the first column of the Schedule of these regulations, replace the amount set out opposite that provision in the second column with the amount set out opposite that provision in the third column.
- 5 Consequential revocation**
The Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Amendment Regulations 2013 (SR 2013/22) are revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2014, amend Schedule 2 of the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Regulations 2005 by increasing the limits on certain allowable costs for which temporary additional support may be granted.

The increase in the amount in clause 3(a) of that schedule reflects a 2.1% increase in the actual rentals for the housing component of the New Zealand Consumers Price Index from the December 2012 quarter to the December 2013 quarter.

The other increases reflect a 1.38% increase in the New Zealand Consumers Price Index from the December 2012 quarter to the December 2013 quarter (calculated for all quarters using the Consumers Price Index (All Groups), excluding cigarettes and other tobacco products).
