## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 5 September 2014, inserts the name Education Payroll Limited into Schedule 4A of the Public Finance Act 1989. Adding Education Payroll Limited to Schedule 4A means that, under section 45OA of the Public Finance Act 1989, certain provisions of the Crown Entities Act 2004 apply to the company

as if it were a Crown entity company under the Crown Entities Act 2004.
