Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Rugby World Cup 2011 (Dissolution) Regulations 2014.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Dissolution of Rugby World Cup Authority

The date specified for the purposes of section 15(1) of the Rugby World Cup 2011 (Empowering) Act 2010 is the date on which these regulations come into force.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date on which they are notified in the *Gazette*, specify the date on which the Rugby World Cup Authority (the **Authority**), established by the Rugby World Cup 2011 (Empowering) Act 2010 (the **Act**), is dissolved by that Act.

The effect of the regulations is that, on the date on which they come into force, the Authority is dissolved (by section 15(1) of the Act) and the Act is expired (by section 9(2)) of the Act.
