## Order

### 1 Title

This order is the Building (Dam Safety) Regulations Revocation Order 2015.

### 2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 30 June 2015.

### 3 Revocation

The Building (Dam Safety) Regulations 2008 (SR 2008/208) are revoked.

This order is revoked on 31 July 2015.

## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 30 June 2015 and is revoked on 31 July 2015, revokes the Building (Dam Safety) Regulations 2008 (the **principal regulations**). The principal regulations were due to come into force on 1 July 2015. They provide for a number of matters relating to dam safety, including—

- setting out a methodology for classifying dams; and
- prescribing competencies for recognised engineers; and
- providing forms for a dam classification certificate, a dam safety assurance programme, and an annual dam compliance certificate.
