**1 Title**

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Area/Rohe Moana of Te Rūnanga o Awarua) Notice 2015.

#### 4 Customary food gathering area/rohe moana

This notice applies to the customary food gathering area/rohe moana defined by clause 2(c) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Notice (No. 42) 2003 (*Gazette* 2003, p 2883), which is an area around Ruapuke Island, in the Foveaux Strait.

#### 5 Reappointments

- (1) The Minister for Primary Industries has appointed Ricky James Topi and Christine Mary Young for further terms as Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki of the area/rohe moana.
- (2) The appointments—
  - (a) took effect on 27 May 2015; and
  - (b) expire at the end of 26 May 2020.

#### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* and revokes itself on 27 May 2020.

This notice relates to a customary food gathering area/rohe moana of the tangata whenua represented by Te Rūnanga o Awarua. The area is located around Ruapuke Island, in the Foveaux Strait.

Notice is given of the reappointment of 2 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the customary food gathering area/rohe moana. The Minister reappointed the Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki under regulation 9(5) of the regulations at the request of Te Rūnanga o Awarua.

A Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for a customary food gathering area/rohe moana may authorise any individual to take fish, aquatic life, or seaweed for customary food gathering purposes from within the area/rohe moana.
