Notice

1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Mātaitai Reserve at Pikomamaku) Notice 2015.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Revocation of this notice

This notice is revoked on 1 August 2020.

4 Mātaitai reserve

This notice applies to the mātaitai reserve at Pikomamaku (Women's Island), on the east side of Stewart Island, that was declared by the Fisheries (Declaration of Pikomamaku Mātaitai Reserve and Appointment of Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki) Notice 2010 (*Gazette* 2010, p 1850).

5 Reappointments

The Minister for Primary Industries has appointed the following people for a further term of 5 years as Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the mātaitai reserve:

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* and revokes itself on 1 August 2020.

This notice relates to the mātaaitai reserve at Pikomamaku (Women’s Island), on the east side of Stewart Island.

Notice is given of the reappointment of 2 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the mātaaitai reserve. The earlier appointments expired at the end of 7 July 2015. The Minister reappointed the Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki under regulation 22(3) of the regulations at the request of Te Rūnanga o Awarua, which represents the tangata whenua of the area that includes the mātaaitai reserve.

The Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for a mātaaitai reserve may—

- ask the Minister to recommend the making of regulations to allow commercial fishing of certain species within the mātaaitai reserve:
- make bylaws restricting or prohibiting the taking of fish, aquatic life, or seaweed from within the mātaaitai reserve:
- authorise the continued taking of fish, aquatic life, or seaweed from within the mātaaitai reserve for purposes that sustain the functions of a marae:
- authorise the relocation of fish, aquatic life, or seaweed within the mātaaitai reserve for the purpose of enhancing stocks.
