



## Fisheries (Notification of Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaitai Reserve and Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki) Notice 2016

Pursuant to regulation 22 of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999, the Director-General of the Ministry for Primary Industries gives the following notice.

### Notice

#### 1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaitai Reserve and Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki) Notice 2016.

#### 2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* (the **commencement date**).

#### 3 Notification of Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaitai Reserve

- (1) A mātaītai reserve (to be known as Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaitai Reserve) has been declared under regulation 20 of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 over the area enclosed by a line—
- (a) commencing at a point on the mean high-water mark near the southern end of Washdyke Lagoon at 44°22.14'S and 171°15.04'E; then
  - (b) proceeding in a straight line due east for approximately 500 metres to a point offshore at 44°22.14'S and 171°15.43'E; then
  - (c) proceeding in a straight line due south for approximately 1.6 kilometres to a point on the mean high-water mark at the end of the Caroline Bay Wharf at 44°23.03'S and 171°15.43'E; then

- (d) proceeding along the mean high-water mark on the north-western side of the Caroline Bay Wharf, in a south-westerly direction; then
  - (e) proceeding in a generally northerly direction along the mean high-water mark to the point of commencement specified in paragraph (a).
- (2) The declaration of the reserve takes effect on the commencement date.

#### **4 Notification of appointment of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki**

## Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

Notice is given that a mātaaitai reserve (to be known as Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaaitai Reserve) has been declared under regulation 20 of the regulations (*see* the Fisheries (Declaration of Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaaitai Reserve) Notice 2016). Te Ahi Tarakihi Mātaaitai Reserve is located in South Island fisheries waters to the north of Timaru. The tangata whenua of the area that includes the reserve are represented by Te Rūnanga o Arowhenua.

Notice is given of the appointment of 16 Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for the mātaaitai reserve. The powers of the Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
