Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings specified provisions of the Social Security (Extension of Young Persons Services and Remedial Matters) Amendment Act 2016 (the **Act**) into force on 25 October 2016.

Most of the Act's provisions came into force on 8 July 2016 (the day after the date on which the Act received the Royal assent).

However, listed provisions come into force on a later date, or on any later different dates, appointed under section 2(1) of the Act.

This order appoints 25 October 2016 as the date on which most of the listed provisions (those specified in *clause 2*) come into force.
