Regulations

- 1 Title**
These regulations are the Heavy Motor Vehicle Amendment Regulations 2016.
- 2 Commencement**
These regulations come into force on 1 February 2017.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1974 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 5 amended (Use of roads and general weight limitations)

Revoke regulation 5(1).

5 Regulation 7 amended (Permits to exceed weight limits)

Revoke regulation 7(1A).

6 Regulation 12 amended (Road construction zones)

In regulation 12(4), replace “Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Dimensions and Mass 2002” with “Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Dimensions and Mass 2016”.

7 Schedule 4A revoked

Revoke Schedule 4A.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 February 2017, amend the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1974 (the **principal regulations**).

Regulations 4 and 6 amend the principal regulations to reflect the replacement of the Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Dimensions and Mass 2002 with the Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Dimensions and Mass 2016. The Land Transport Rule: Vehicle Dimensions and Mass 2016 comes into force on the same day as these regulations.

Regulations 5 and 7 revoke provisions of the principal regulations relating to fees for permits.

Regulatory impact statement

The Ministry of Transport produced a regulatory impact statement on 9 June 2016 to help inform the decisions taken by the Government relating to the contents of this instrument.
