### **Notice**

**1 Title**

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for Area/Rohe Moana of Te Rūnanga o Kaikōura) Notice 2016.

**2 Commencement**

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**3 Revocation of this notice**

This notice is revoked at the end of 30 October 2021.

**4 Customary food gathering area/rohe moana**

This notice applies to the customary food gathering area/rohe moana defined by clause 2(c) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Notice (No. 4) 2011 (*Gazette* 2011, p 1694), which is an area along the Kaikōura coast between the Clarence and Hurunui Rivers.

This notice is made under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette* and revokes itself at the end of 30 October 2021.

The notice relates to a customary food gathering area/rohe moana of the tangata whenua represented by Te Rūnanga o Kaikōura. The area/rohe moana is an area along the Kaikōura coast between the Clarence and Hurunui Rivers.
