Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 22 May 2017, amend the Births, Deaths, Marriages, and Relationships Registration (Fees) Regulations 1995 (the **principal regulations**).

These regulations amend the Schedule of the principal regulations, which sets out the fees to be paid in relation to certain matters under the Births, Deaths, Marriages, and Relationships Registration Act 1995.

The amendments change the amounts of most of the fees set out in the Schedule.
