Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Veterans' Support Amendment Regulations (No 4) 2017.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 19 January 2018.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Veterans' Support Regulations 2014 (the **principal regulations**).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 19 January 2018, amend the Veterans' Support Regulations 2014 (the **principal regulations**).

These regulations amend Schedule 1 of the principal regulations, which lists the Australian statements of principles that apply to specified medical conditions for the purposes of the Veterans' Support Act 2014.

The amendments replace statements of principles references for 10 conditions and add statements of principles references for 5 conditions.
