Order

1 Title

This order is the Rates Rebate (Specified Amounts) Order 2018.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 July 2018.

3 Section 3 of Rates Rebate Act 1973 amended

- (1) In the Rates Rebate Act 1973, section 3(1)(a)(ii), replace “\$24,790” with “\$25,180”.
- (2) In the Rates Rebate Act 1973, section 3(1)(b), replace “\$620” with “\$630”.

4 Revocation

The Rates Rebate (Specified Amounts) Order 2017 (LI 2017/110) is revoked.

5 Saving

A ratepayer’s entitlement to a rebate for a rating year ending before 1 July 2018, and the amount (if any) of that rebate, must be determined as if this order had not been made.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 2018, amends section 3(1) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973. Section 3(1) provides for a rates rebate for low-income home owners. This order—

- increases the income threshold for a rates rebate from \$24,790 to \$25,180; and
- increases the maximum rates rebate from \$620 to \$630.
