1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (Notification of Oaro Mātaitai Reserve and Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki) Notice 2018.

2 Commencement

This notice comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Notification of mātaītai reserve

- (1) This notice applies to Oaro Mātaitai Reserve, south of Kaikoura that is declared by the Fisheries (Declaration of Oaro Mātaitai Reserve) Notice 2018.
- (2) The declaration of the mātaītai reserve takes effect on the commencement of this notice.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice is given under the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999 (the **regulations**). It comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

The notice relates to Oaro Mātaitai Reserve, which is south of Kaikoura. Oaro Mātaitai Reserve was declared by the Fisheries (Declaration of Oaro Mātaitai Reserve) Notice 2018. It comprises the area of Oaro Mātaitai (which had been declared by section 22 of the Kaikōura (Te Tai o Marokura) Marine Management Act 2014) and an area that extends the boundaries of Oaro Mātaitai to include the South Island fisheries waters in the lower reaches of the Oaro River. Section 25 of the Act provided that Oaro Mātaitai was to be treated as if it were declared by a notice in the *Gazette* given under regulation 20 of the regulations.

The tangata whenua of the area that includes the mātaitai reserve are represented by Te Rūnanga o Kaikōura. The Minister of Fisheries made the appointments at the request of Te Rūnanga o Kaikōura.

The powers of Tāngata Tiaki/Kaitiaki are set out in the regulations.
