Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Social Security (Family Violence) Amendment Regulations 2019.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 July 2019.

3 Principal regulations

These regulations amend the Social Security Regulations 2018 (the **principal regulations**).

4 Regulation 3 amended (Interpretation)

In regulation 3(1), definition of **family violence**, replace “domestic violence as that term is defined in section 3 of the Domestic Violence Act 1995” with “family violence as that term is defined in section 9 of the Family Violence Act 2018”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 2019, amend the Social Security Regulations 2018 (the **principal regulations**). The amendments align the principal regulations with the Family Violence Act 2018, which also comes into force on 1 July 2019.
