## **Domestic Violence—Victims’ Protection Bill**

### *Proposed amendments to Supplementary Order Paper No 39*

Clayton Mitchell, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

#### *Clause 7*

In *clause 7, new section 69AB(b)* (page 11), replace “5 working days” with “10 working days”.

In *clause 7, new section 69ABE(1)* (page 13), replace “5 working days” with “10 working days”.

In *clause 7, new section 69ABEA(1)(e)* (page 14), replace “5 working days” with “10 working days”.

In *clause 7, new section 69ABF(1)(a)* (page 14), replace “5 working days” with “10 working days”.

In *clause 7, new section 69ABG(4)(a) and (b)* (page 15), replace “5 working days” with “10 working days”.

### **Explanatory note**

The purpose of this Supplementary Order Paper is to extend the time within which an employer is required to deal with a request for flexible working short-term for people affected by domestic violence from 5 working days to 10 working days.
