Title.

AN ACT to constitute the Egmont County.

[2nd November, 1901.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short Title.

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Egmont County Act, 1901.”

Commencement of Act.

2. This Act shall come into force on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and two.

Constitution of county.

3. The Egmont County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise all those portions of the Parihaka Riding of the County of Taranaki and the Waimate Riding of the County of Hawera respectively which are included within the boundaries particularly described in the Schedule hereto.

Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

BOUNDARIES OF THE EGMONT COUNTY.

ALL that area in the Land District of Taranaki bounded by a line commencing at the summit of Mount Egmont, and proceeding thence southerly along a straight line to a point in the middle of the north end of the Auroa Road at its junction with the Forest Reserve boundary; thence southerly along the middle of the said road to its junction with the southern boundary of Block IX., Kaipokonui Survey District; thence westerly along the said southern boundary to the middle of the Oeo Road; thence southerly along the middle of the Oeo Road to a point in the middle of the Oeo Road and in a direct line with the southern boundary of Section 20, Block I., Waimate Survey District; thence easterly to and along the southern boundary of the said Section 20 to its junction with the eastern boundary of Block II., Oeo Survey District; thence southerly along the said eastern boundary and the eastern boundary of Block III. to the sea-coast; thence northerly along the said sea-coast to the north-west corner of Section 26, Block IV., Cape Survey

District; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said Section 26 to the western side of the Coast Road; thence easterly across the Coast Road to a point in the middle of the Puniho Road at its junction with the Coast Road; thence easterly along the middle of the Puniho Road to its junction with the Forest Reserve boundary; thence easterly along a straight line to the point of commencement at the summit of Mount Egmont aforesaid.
