- Title.** AN ACT to change the Purposes for which a certain Portion of the Public Reserve known as "Russell Park," situated in the Town District of Waipukurau, was vested in the Waipukurau Town Board. [24th December, 1909.]
- Preamble.** WHEREAS by Proclamation made on the twenty-fifth day of September, nineteen hundred and seven, and published in the *Gazette* of the third day of October, nineteen hundred and seven, the piece of land described in the Schedule hereto was (with other land) taken for the purposes of a public recreation-ground and vested in the Waipukurau Town Board: And whereas the said piece of land, being cut off from the remainder of the land described in the said Proclamation by a public road, is not required for the purposes aforesaid: And whereas the Waipukurau Town Board is desirous of using the said piece of land for the purposes of a public pound:
- BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
- Short Title.** 1. This Act may be cited as the Waipukurau Reserve Act, 1909.
- Site for a public pound.** 2. The piece of land described in the Schedule hereto shall no longer be appropriated as an endowment for the purposes hereinbefore recited, but shall be and remain vested in the Waipukurau Town Board for the purposes of a public pound.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that piece of land, situated in the Hawke's Bay Land District, containing 4 acres 1 rood 30 perches, more or less, situated in the Waipukurau Town District, being part of Native Reserve 30N: bounded towards the west by the Napier Road, 876 links; towards the north-east by the Tukituki River bed, 1099·5 links; and towards the south-east by other part of the said Native Reserve 30N, being the lot numbered 4 on a plan deposited in the Land Transfer Office at Napier under No. 1607, 1000 links: be all the same linkages a little more or less.
