An Act to constitute the Dannevirke Hospital District.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Short Title and commencement.

This Act may be cited as the Dannevirke Hospital District Act, 1924, and shall commence on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, save that all elections, appointments, Orders in Council, notices, or regulations required for the purpose of bringing this Act into operation on that date may be held, made, or issued at any time after the passing of this Act.

2 Dannevirke Hospital District constituted.

- (1.) There is hereby constituted a hospital district under the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909, to be called the Dannevirke Hospital District, which shall comprise the counties of Dannevirke, Woodville, and Weber.

Alteration of boundaries of Waipawa Hospital District.

- (2.) The boundaries of the Waipawa Hospital District are hereby altered by excluding therefrom the Dannevirke, Weber, and Woodville Counties.

3 Dannevirke Hospital Board.

- (1.) Subject to the provisions of section nine of the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909, the Board of the Dannevirke Hospital District shall consist of such number of representatives of the contributory districts within the hospital district as the Governor-General, by Order in Council, from time to time determines.

First election of members.

- (2.) The first election of members of the said Board shall be held on such day as the Governor-General, by Order in Council, appoints; and by the same or any subsequent Order in Council the Governor-General may make all such provisions as are deemed necessary for the purposes of that election.

4 Apportionment of assets and liabilities.

The Governor-General shall, by Order in Council, determine what part (if any) of the property, contracts, debts, and liabilities of the Waipawa Hospital Board, as at the commencement of this Act, shall become the property, contracts, debts, and liabilities of the Dannevirke Hospital Board, and the said Order in Council shall have effect according to the tenor thereof.
