AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Fund the Title.
 Sum of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Pounds
 (£150,000) to the Service of the Year ending the
 Thirtieth day of June One thousand eight hundred
 and seventy-two. [2nd September 1871.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
 in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same
 as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Imprest Supply Short Title.
 Act 1871.”

2. Out of the Consolidated Fund there may be issued and applied £150,000 advanced
on Imprest towards
service of year ending
30th June 1872.
 towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty by way of
 Imprest for the service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June
 one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two in addition to the sums
 mentioned in the Civil List Act and other Acts any sums of money
 not exceeding one hundred and fifty thousand pounds (£150,000)
 to be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or
 Acts passed in this present Session of Parliament for appropriating the
 Consolidated Revenues of the Colony for the year ending the thirtieth
 day of June one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two.
