AN ACT to enlarge the Time wherein Reserves for Natives may be made
under "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1880."

[1st July, 1882.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament
assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, Short Title,
1882."

2. The period during which reserves of land may be made by the Governor
under the third section of "The Waikato Confiscated Lands Act, 1880," is
hereby extended, and any such reserve may be made under the aforesaid section
at any time before the expiration of two years from the passing of this Act.
