AN ACT to amend the Coal-mines Act, 1925.

Title.

[22nd December, 1933.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Coal-mines Amendment Act, 1933, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Coal-mines Act, 1925.

Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in section thirty-nine of the Public Works Act, 1928, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Mines to demise, on such terms and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit, for any period not exceeding sixty years, any land taken under that Act for providing access to land subject to Part III of the Coal-mines Act, 1925, and the rents and profits thereof shall be paid into the Public Account to the credit of the State Coal-mines Account.

Minister of Mines may demise certain lands.
