An Act to validate and confirm certain regulations expressed to be made under the authority of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953

WHEREAS by sections 3 and 4 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953 it is provided that all regulations made under that Act shall be laid before Parliament and shall expire on the last day of the session in which they are laid except so far as they are expressly validated or confirmed by an Act of Parliament passed during that session: And whereas the regulations specified in section 2 of this Act have been laid before Parliament during the present session: And whereas doubts have been expressed as to whether their making was authorised by the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953: And whereas it is desired to validate those regulations and to confirm them as if in every way they had been validly made and laid before Parliament under the authority of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953:

Be it therefore enacted by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Primary Products Marketing Regulations Validation and Confirmation Act 1975.

2 Regulations validated and confirmed

- (1) The Egg Marketing (Production Entitlement) Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 1, are hereby declared to be valid and to always have been valid and to have been made under the authority of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953.
- (2) The said regulations are hereby confirmed as required by section 4 of the Primary Products Marketing Act 1953.

This Act is administered in the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries.
