An Act to amend the Social Security Act 1964

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1 Short Title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Social Security Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Social Security Act 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- (2) Sections 2(3), 12 to 17, 25, 29, 32, 34, and 40(2) of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1991.
- (3) Section 40(1)(a) of this Act shall come into force on the 2nd day of March 1991.
- (4) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1991.
