**An Act to amend the Valuation of Land Act 1951**

[28 June 1991]

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Valuation of Land Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Valuation of Land Act 1951 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1991.

**2. Valuation roll to be rating roll for local authorities**—Section 28 of the principal Act (as substituted by section 18 of the Valuation of Land Amendment Act 1988) is hereby amended by repealing subsection (5), and substituting the following subsection:

“(5) There shall be payable—

“(a) By every local authority that is supplied with a valuation roll by the Valuer-General; and

“(b) By every local authority that uses, either directly or indirectly, the information on the valuation roll to raise rating revenue,—

a reasonable charge, or, as the case may require, a share of the reasonable charge, for preparing, supplying, and maintaining the roll, as determined from time to time by the Valuer-General.”

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This Act is administered in the Valuation Department.

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
