An Act to amend the Social Security Act 1964

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1 Short Title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Social Security Amendment Act 1997, and is part of the Social Security Act 1964 (**the principal Act**).

This Act is administered by the Ministry of Social Development.
