An Act to amend the Investment Advisers (Disclosure) Act 1996

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1 Short Title

This Act may be cited as the Investment Advisers (Disclosure) Amendment Act 1998, and is part of the Investment Advisers (Disclosure) Act 1996 (“the principal Act”).

2 Interpretation

- (1) This subsection substituted paragraph (b) of the definitions of the terms **investment broker** and **broker** in s 2(1) of the principal Act.
- (2) This subsection substituted the definitions of the terms **investment money** and **money** in s 2(1) of the principal Act.
- (3) This subsection substituted the definitions of the terms **investment property** and **property** in s 2(1) of the principal Act.

3 Initial disclosure by investment advisers and investment brokers

- (1) This subsection amended s 3(2) of the principal Act.
