An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1961 to increase penalties for certain offences involving home invasion

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1 Short Title and commencement

- (1) This Act may be cited as the Crimes (Home Invasion) Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Crimes Act 1961 (“the principal Act”).
- (2) This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

- 2 New heading and sections inserted**

- 3 Punishment of manslaughter**
This section inserted s 177(2) to (4) of the principal Act.
- 4 Consequential amendments to principal Act**
