The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Electoral Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act, the Electoral Act 1993 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Election of list candidates

- (1) Section 127(4) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the words “a copy of”.
- (2) Section 127 of the principal Act is amended by repealing subsection (5), and substituting the following subsection:
“(5) Every consent submitted under subsection (4)—

- “(a) must be in a form provided by the Chief Electoral Officer; and
 - “(b) must be signed by the person concerned; and
 - “(c) may be submitted by hand, post, or facsimile transmission.”
- (3) Schedule 2 of the principal Act is consequentially amended by repealing form 5.
