The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Medicines (Specified Biotechnical Procedures) Amendment Act 2005.
- (2) In this Act the Medicines Act 1981 is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Expiry of this Part

- (1) Section 96J(1) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the words “30 June 2003”, and substituting the words “31 December 2006”.
- (2) Section 96J(2) of the principal Act is amended by omitting the words “, but that substituted date may not be later than 30 June 2005”.
