The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title**
This Act is the Crown Entities Amendment Act 2010.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
- 3 Principal Act amended**
This Act amends the Crown Entities Act 2004.
- 4 Method of appointment of members**
 - (1) Section 28(3) is amended by omitting “; and” in the second place where it appears and also by repealing paragraph (c).

- (2) Section 28 is amended by adding the following subsection:
- “(4) The responsible Minister must ensure that the following are notified in the *Gazette* as soon as is reasonably practicable after an appointment is made:
- “(a) the name of the appointee and the statutory entity; and
 - “(b) the date on which the appointment takes effect; and
 - “(c) the term of the appointment.”
