### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

#### **1 Title**

This Act is the Local Electoral (Advertising) Amendment Act 2022.

#### **2 Commencement**

This Act comes into force on 1 July 2022.

#### **3 Principal Act**

This Act amends the Local Electoral Act 2001.

#### **4 Section 113 amended (Advertisements for candidates)**

(1) Replace section 113(2)(b) with:

(b) the advertisement contains a statement setting out the true name and contact details of the person or persons for whom or at whose direction it is published.

(2) Replace section 113(4)(b)(i) with:

(i) the true name and contact details of the person or persons for whom or at whose direction it is published; and

- (3) After section 113(6), insert:
- (7) In this section, **contact details** means 1 or more of the following:
- (a) a residential or business address:
  - (b) an email address:
  - (c) a post office box number:
  - (d) a phone number:
  - (e) a link to a page on an Internet site, if the page contains 1 or more of the contact details specified in paragraphs (a) to (d).
