## Regulations

### 1 Title

These regulations are the Social Security (Application of Work Test Obligations) Regulations 2007.

### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 24 September 2007.

### 3 Interpretation

In these regulations,—

**Act** means the Social Security Act 1964

**weekend day** means—

- (a) a Saturday;
- (b) a Sunday.

### 4 Application of work test obligations

- (1) The work test obligations set out in section 102A(1)(b) and (c) of the Act apply Monday to Sunday (inclusive).
