1 Title

This notice is the Fisheries (High Seas Fishing Notifications: Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission) Notice 2009.

For the purposes of Part 6A of the Fisheries Act 1996 and the definition of international conservation and management measures in section 113B of that Act, the conservation and management measures adopted by the Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission that are set out in the Schedule of this notice are measures within the meaning of that definition.
