- 1 Title**  
These rules are the Child Support Amendment Rules 2013.

**2 Commencement**

These rules come into force on 1 July 2013.

**3 Principal rules**

These rules amend the Child Support Rules 1992 (the **principal rules**).

**4 Rule 57 amended (Procedure on arrest of respondent other than in respect of offence)**

In rule 57(5) replace “section 57 of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957” with “section 39 of the Bail Act 2000”.
